7. Applications/Hearings

(a) 1945516 Ontario Inc. o/a Eastern Flavours – Hospitality Food/Liquor Licence

Mr. Ahmed Zabian and Mr. Farid Rhaman are present and available to answer questions.

C. Robertson indicates that Administration recommends to the Windsor Licensing Commission a refusal to issue a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service Licence as there are ongoing issues with the Public Works Department and consistently failing to maintain their grease trap. He adds the licence has not been issued at this point pending approval by Fire & Rescue Services.

K. Passa advises when inspectors make an assessment of the grease trap, a screwdriver is inserted into the contents to determine the amount of oil. If there are more than 2 inches of grease, the restauranteur is requested to skim the grease off the top.

Mr. Zabian disagrees with the grease trap procedure and adds the inspector opens the grease trap lid and closes it immediately. He adds he has retained a company to clean the grease trap every six weeks and the grease is skimmed on a weekly basis.

C. Robertson states the Commission could provide an extension of time to allow the applicant to work with Pollution Control.

LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS

The attached applications were received by the Licensing Division on October 3, 2018 from Mr. Chuck Clark, on behalf of 1287609 Ontario Ltd., Plate Holder of Taxicab #32, and on October 4, 2018 from Mr. Peter Kelly for the prospective transfer of Taxicab Plate #32.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 states:

"20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.

20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.

20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.

20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:

- (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
- (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
- (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
- (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
- (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Further, Section 21.3 states:

"A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (1) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;
- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

BACKGROUND

- October 3, 2018, transfer application and fee was received from Mr. Chuck Clark on behalf of 1287609 Ontario Ltd., being Appendix "A"
- October 4, 2018, transferee application for Mr. Peter Kelly was submitted, being Appendix "B".
- October 4, 2018, proof of full-time status as a taxicab driver was received by Mr. Kelly

SUMMARY

According to the AMANDA database, 1287609 Ontario Ltd. has been the plate holder of taxicab plate #32 annually since at least 1998 and is therefore compliant with Section 20.1 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007.

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #32 be transferred to Mr. Peter Kelly, who is currently not a licensed plate holder. Further, Licensing records indicate that Mr. Kelly has been licensed as a taxicab driver since at least 1997. Mr. Kelly also holds a current place on the Taxicab Driver's Waiting List which qualifies him to be a Taxicab Plate Holder. Administration is prepared to recommend that the transfer be completed pending the following outstanding items:

Mr. Peter Kelly must provide:

- (a) Verification of an appropriate vehicle to which he will affix taxicab plate #32, including a valid safety standards certificate
- (b) A completed Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee
- (c) Verification that full compensation has been made to 1287609 Ontario Ltd. in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #32

RECOMMENDATION

To the Windsor Licensing Commission for decision on the following:

THAT the transfer of Taxicab Plate #32 from 1287609 Ontario Ltd. to Mr. Peter Kelly **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- i. Mr. Kelly be given thirty (30) days from the date of this decision to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007, including a valid safety standards certificate.
- ii. Mr. Kelly must submit a Plate Holder application and pay the applicable fee.
- iii. Mr. Kelly shall provide verification that full compensation has been made to 1287609 Ontario Ltd. in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #32.
- iv. Mr. Kelly shall not lease the plate for a one year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing By-law 137-2007.

An application for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence at 6675 Tecumseh Road East, Windsor, ON N8T 1E7 was submitted on January 17, 2018 by Mr. Karthikeyan Kandaiyapillai Subramaniam on behalf of Kings Management Corp. o/a Chuck's Roadhouse Bar & Grill. Licensing records indicate that although this is the only licence for Kings Management Corp., Mr. Subramaniam is also the owner of Chuck's Roadhouse Bar & Grill at 5001 Legacy Park Drive under a different corporation.

REGULATORY AUTHORITY

Business Licensing By-Law 395-2004

3.1 Licensing – powers

The power to license, regulate and govern a business, trade or occupation includes the power,

- (2) to refuse to grant a licence or to revoke or suspend a licence;
- (6) to impose special conditions on a business in a class that have not been imposed on all of the businesses in that class in order to obtain, continue to hold or renew a licence;
- (7) to impose conditions, including special conditions, as a requirement of continuing to hold a licence at any time during the term of the licence;

3.8 Licence - application - subject to approval

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as

directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

3.9 Contravention - other laws - prohibited

The issuance or renewal of a licence is not intended and shall not be construed as permission or consent by the City for the holder of the licence to contravene or to fail to observe or comply with any law of Canada or Ontario or any by-law of the City.

3.12 Information - held by Licence Commissioner - open to inspection

(1) Any application, comment, recommendation, information, document or thing in the possession of the Licence Commissioner pursuant to the provisions of this by-law shall be made available by the Licence Commissioner for an inspection:

- a. by any person employed in the administration or the enforcement of this by-law; and
- b. by any other person upon the consent, satisfactory to the Licence Commissioner, of the person, civic department, board, commission, authority or other agency which produced or submitted the application, comment, recommendation, information, document or thing; subject only to the limitations imposed by the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.

3.31 Refusal - suspension - revocation - by Windsor Licensing Commission – hearing

(1) At the hearing, the Windsor Licensing Commission may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any licence under this by-law:

- (a) for any reason that would disentitle the holder to a licence if he/she were an applicant;
- (b) where the holder of the licence or applicant is in breach of a condition of the licence or of this by-law;
- (c) if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the statements on the licence application are false;
- (d) if a report is filed subsequent to the date of the issuance of the licence by any department or agency which provided its approval originally to the issuance of the licence which indicates that a licensed premises no longer complies with any of the provisions of this by-law;
- (e) upon such grounds as are set out in this by-law;
- (f) if the applicant has outstanding fines or penalties owing to the municipality or has not paid the required licence application fee;
- (g) if the conduct or character of the applicant or licensee affords reasonable cause to believe that the applicant or licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;
- (h) if the geographic location of the business does not meet land use requirements;
- (i) if, in the case of a corporate applicant or licensee, the conduct of its officers, directors, employees or agents affords reasonable cause to believe that the business will not be engaged in or carried on in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity; or
- (j) if issuing a licence is not in the public interest.

BACKGROUND

- January 17, 2018, Mr. Karthikeyan Kandaiyapillai Subramaniam makes application

on behalf of Kings Management Corp. o/a Chuck's Roadhouse Bar & Grill for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence.

- March 22, 2018, a letter is sent to Mr. Kandaiyapillai Subramaniam at the request of Public Works after three failed inspections on January 25, 2018, February 16, 2018 and March 21, 2018.
- March 28, 2018, Public Works conducts another inspection and approves the premises.
- April 3, 2018, Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence #18 106754 is issued.
- September 7, 2018, Ken Passa, Supervisor of Environmental Quality contacts Craig Robertson, Supervisor of Licensing & Deputy Licence Commissioner, to inform him of an ongoing history of non-compliance with respect to the applicant maintaining the establishment's grease trap and emails the following history:
 - January 24, 2018, Grease trap was grouted shut. Advised to have opened and cleaned and to call for re-inspection.
 - February 14, 2018, Grease trap required cleaning, advised to monitor for grease to determine cleaning schedule.
 - March 21, 2018, Grease trap required cleaning, advised to monitor for grease to determine cleaning schedule.
 - March 28, 2018, Grease trap clean. Advised to open once a week and skim after oil reaches 3-4 inches on the surface of the trap..
 - July 13, 2018, Grease trap requires cleaning. Stated will be cleaned on Wednesday next week.
 - July 24, 2018, Grease trap requires cleaning, about 4 inches on surface.
 - August 14, 2018, 4" of oil in grease trap. Informed manager. Manager had me show kitchen staff how to open trap and skim oil.
 - September 6, 2018, A thick layer of grease in the trap. They stated it was cleaned last Wednesday. Advised to clean out twice weekly.

SUMMARY

Administration is concerned with the ongoing history of non-compliance, as reference above, with the requirements governed by Public Works. The Licensing Division has a responsibility to ensure that the licensee operates in accordance with all laws. Administration does not oppose the continuance of this licence, but suggests that the Windsor Licensing Commission impose certain conditions on the licence in order to protect the public.

RECOMMENDATION:


