When opening my restaurant I went through all of the departments and licensing requirements that I had to. I was given a clean bill of health in all areas. I was told everything had been done properly and I was ready to open my restaurant. All people and inspectors I had to deal with, said I was in good standing, hands were shaken good luck wishes were said.

Around June 14/18 I was given a phone call by Shannon Tilson asking me for now something more, I did not understand her at all. It was not clear to me who this person was and why she was calling me. I did not understand who she worked for and got very nervous. I then asked her to mail me what ever she wanted. After getting off the phone I looked at all my papers that said I was approved for my restaurant and tried to make any sense of the phone call. Two weeks later I received a letter in the mail, now asking me for my liquor licence . I had a friend read the letter and he told me, all they wanted was a copy of the liquor licence. The deadline on the letter said the 29th of June . Again I did not receive the letter until a day earlier which was all ready past due.


I tried calling the city and also going down to see several people . The liquor licence in question was dropped off at this time. And now they say my licence has expired .

I feel this is not my fault, I was told I was good to go and everything had been done that needed to be. In pervious letters there was no mention that I still had to bring any licence anywhere. I was not given enough time once the letter arrived that expired on June 29/18. It arrived past the due date, how could I have done anything.

Also in your letter to me it states that " it has come to our attention that we were missing your liquor licence " this sounds like your mistake in telling me I was all done and good to go. Now that you have had a copy of my liquor license, I feel that this matter should be resolved and once again I should be in good standing with all parties concerned.

Please allow my licence to continue, again I'm very sorry for any part that I may be at fault.

## **LICENCE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS**

The attached applications were received by the Licensing Division on August 31, 2018 from Mr. Mohamed Ali, Plate Holder of Taxicab #136, and from Mr. Mr. Fadi Nizam for the prospective transfer of Taxicab Plate #136.

### **REGULATORY AUTHORITY**

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 states:

*"20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.*

*20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.*

*20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.*

*20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable,*

provided that:

- (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
- (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
- (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
- (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
- (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Further, Section 21.3 states:

"A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (1) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;
- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

## **BACKGROUND**

- August 31, 2018, transfer application and fee was received from Mr. Mohamed Ali, being Appendix "A"
- August 31, 2018, transferee application for Mr. Fadi Nizam was submitted, being Appendix "B".
- September 5, 2018, proof of full-time status as a taxicab driver was received by Mr. Nizam

## **SUMMARY**

According to the AMANDA database, Mr. Mohamed Ali has been the plate holder of taxicab #136 annually since 2010 and is therefore compliant with Section 20.1 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007.

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #136 be transferred to Mr. Fadi Nizam, who is currently not a licensed plate holder. Further, Licensing records indicate that Mr. Nizam has been licensed as a taxicab driver since June 27, 2014. Although Mr. Nizam does not hold a current place on the Drivers' List, he has provided proof that he has been employed as a full-time taxicab driver since October 30, 2015, which satisfies the requirements of Section 20.4(a) of Schedule 5.

Administration is prepared to recommend that the transfer be completed pending the following outstanding items:

Mr. Fadi Nizam must provide:

- (a) Verification of an appropriate vehicle to which he will affix taxicab plate #136
- (b) A completed Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee
- (c) Verification that full compensation has been made to Mr. Mohamed Ali in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #136

## **RECOMMENDATION**

To the Windsor Licensing Commission for decision on the following:

**THAT** the transfer of Taxicab Plate #136 from Mr. Mohamed Ali to Mr. Fadi Nizam **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- i. Mr. Nizam be given thirty (30) days from the date of this decision to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007.
- ii. Mr. Nizam must submit a Plate Holder application and pay the applicable fee.
- iii. Mr. Nizam shall provide verification that full compensation has been made to Mr. Ali in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #136.
- iv. Mr. Nizam shall not lease the plate for a one year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing By-law 137-2007.





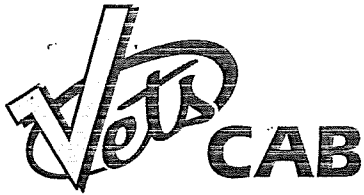

#### **REGULATORY AUTHORITY**

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 states:

*"20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.*

*20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.*

*20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.*

20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:

- (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
- (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner;
- (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
- (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
- (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate.”

Further, Section 21.3 states:

“A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (1) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;
- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months.”

## **BACKGROUND**

- September 13, 2018, transferee application for Mr. Mohammad Al-Barazi was submitted, being Appendix “B”.

## **SUMMARY**

An application for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence at 4044 Walker Road, Unit 5, Windsor, ON N8W 3T5 was submitted on February 28, 2018 by Mr. Ahmed Zabian on behalf of 1945516 Ontario Inc. o/a Eastern Flavours. Licensing records indicate that Mr. Zabian has been licensed annually since 2016.

## **REGULATORY AUTHORITY**

### **Business Licensing By-Law 395-2004**

#### **3.8 Licence - application - subject to approval**

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

#### **3.25 Licensing powers – Licence Commissioner – issue or renew**

  - (j) if issuing a licence is not in the public interest.

### **BACKGROUND**

- February 28, 2018, Mr. Ahmed Zabian makes application on behalf of 1945516 Ontario Inc. o/a Eastern Flavours for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence.
- August 17, 2018, Ken Passa, Supervisor of Environmental Quality contacts Craig Robertson, Supervisor of Licensing & Deputy Licence Commissioner, to inform him of an ongoing history of non-compliance with respect to the applicant maintaining the establishment's grease trap and emails the following history:
  - March 14, 2017, Grease trap requires cleaning, Advanced waste grease drum on site; grease trap being cleaned every 2-3 months.
  - March 30, 2017, Grease trap not cleaned yet. Advised to clean within the week.
  - April 24, 2017, Grease trap full of oil. Advanced cleaned out on March 31, 2017. Advised to clean out every 2 weeks; gave card to notify us when ready.
  - August 15, 2017, Grease trap full of waste grease/oil. They clean out every 6-8 weeks. Need to be cleaned more frequently.
  - August 23, 2017, Grease trap has a thick layer of grease on the surface; owner states that they are going to clean out every 4 weeks.
  - October 3, 2017, Denied PC licence approval due to inconsistency in cleaning grease trap and not co-operating with dept.
  - April 9, 2018, Grease trap cleaned last month. (4 weeks ago), needs cleaning

- again; advised to clean grease trap out weekly.
- July 5, 2018, Grease trap full of oil. Owner stated he would increase frequency. Instructed owner to open trap weekly and monitor grease build up; need to monitor on a monthly basis.
- August 17, 2018, Grease trap needs to be skimmed. Approx 4" of grease on surface. Advised to increase frequency of cleaning; Advanced cleans trap every time they pick up waste oil.

## **SUMMARY**

Administration recommends to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it refuse to issue a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence to 1945516 Ontario Inc. o/a Eastern Flavours at 4044 Walker Road, Unit 5, Windsor, ON N8W 3T5. It is not in the public interest to issue a licence since they have ongoing issues with the Public Works Department and are consistently failing to maintain their grease trap. Should the Windsor Licensing Commission decide to refuse to issue the licence, the applicant would be required to correct any outstanding deficiencies identified by the Public Works Department, re-apply for their licence and pay the applicable fees.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

### **LICENCE COMMISSIONER’S COMMENTS**

An application for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence at 4044 Walker Road, Unit #6, Windsor, ON N8W 3T5 was submitted on March 20, 2018 by Mr. Louis Mavrantzas on behalf of Stir Crazy Grille Inc. Licensing records indicate that Stir Crazy Grille Inc. has been licensed annually since 2012.

### **REGULATORY AUTHORITY**

#### **Business Licensing By-Law 395-2004**

#### **3.8 Licence - application - subject to approval**

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

#### **3.25 Licensing powers – Licence Commissioner – issue or renew**

- (1) Upon receipt of an application in the prescribed form for a licence or renewal thereof, shall make or cause to be made all investigation required by law and if the investigation disclose any reason to believe that the applicant is not of good character or that the carrying on of the said trade, calling, business or occupation will be likely to result in a breach of the law or be in any way adverse to the public interest, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that

it not issue or renew the licence or that it impose conditions on the issuance of a licence, otherwise, the Licence Commissioner shall recommend to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it issue or renew the licence.

### **3.31 Refusal - suspension - revocation - by Windsor Licensing Commission – hearing**

- (1) At the hearing, the Windsor Licensing Commission may suspend, revoke or refuse to issue any licence under this by-law:
  - (a) for any reason that would disentitle the holder to a licence if he/she were an applicant;
  - (b) where the holder of the licence or applicant is in breach of a condition of the licence or of this by-law;
  - (c) if there are reasonable grounds to believe that the statements on the licence application are false;
  - (d) if a report is filed subsequent to the date of the issuance of the licence by any department or agency which provided its approval originally to the issuance of the licence which indicates that a licensed premises no longer complies with any of the provisions of this by-law;
  - (e) upon such grounds as are set out in this by-law;
  - (f) if the applicant has outstanding fines or penalties owing to the municipality or has not paid the required licence application fee;
  - (g) if the conduct or character of the applicant or licensee affords reasonable cause to believe that the applicant or licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity;
  - (h) if the geographic location of the business does not meet land use requirements;
  - (i) if, in the case of a corporate applicant or licensee, the conduct of its officers, directors, employees or agents affords reasonable cause to believe that the business will not be engaged in or carried on in accordance with the law or with honesty and integrity; or
  - (j) if issuing a licence is not in the public interest.

## **BACKGROUND**

- March 20, 2018, Mr. Louis Mavrantzas makes application on behalf of Stir Crazy Grille Inc. for a Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence.
- July 31, 2018, Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence #18 122788 is issued.
- August 17, 2018, Ken Passa, Supervisor of Environmental Quality contacts Craig Robertson, Supervisor of Licensing & Deputy Licence Commissioner, to inform him of an ongoing history of non-compliance with respect to the applicant maintaining the establishment's grease trap and emails the following history:
  - March 14, 2017, Grease trap requires cleaning; grease Trap Doc cleans trap every 3 months, Advised manager to increase frequency of cleaning.
  - March 30, 2017, Two Grease traps - one under the sink the other in the floor, a thin layer in each trap.
  - April 9, 2018, Large Grease trap was full of oil, has not been cleaned since Christmas; requires cleaning.
  - July 5, 2018, Small Grease trap is cleaned daily, Large grease trap has not been cleaned since April 2018; advised to clean large grease trap on a regular schedule like the small grease trap.
  - August 17, 2018, Large grease trap requires skimming. Frequency needs to increase from every 3 months to weekly monitoring.

**SUMMARY**

Administration recommends to the Windsor Licensing Commission that it suspend the Hospitality Food/Liquor Service licence #18 122788 issued to Stir Crazy Grille Inc. at 4044 Walker Road, Unit 6, Windsor, ON N8W 3T5 until such time as the premises is brought into compliance as requested by the Public Works Department. It is in the interest of public safety to suspend their licence since they have ongoing issues with the Public Works Department and are failing to maintain their grease trap.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT Hospitality Food/Liquor Service Licence #18 122788, issued to Stir Crazy Grille Inc., at 4044 Walker Road, Unit 6, Windsor, ON N8W 3T5, **BE SUSPENDED** until the licensee operates in compliance with the requirements set out by the Public Works Department.

And further THAT,

Hospitality Food/Liquor Service Licence #18 122788, issued to Stir Crazy Grille Inc., **BE REVOKED** should the licensee fail to comply within thirty (30) days from the date of this decision.


