Craig Robertson, Deputy Licence Commissioner advises on February 22, 2023, the Licensing Division received an e-mail notification of the death of plate holder Youssef Farhat. Mr. Farhat had been the plate holder of taxicab plate #123 since 2012. Administration is recommending that Taxicab Plate #123 be transferred to Amin Abdo Al-Goly.

Moved by Councillor Angelo Marignani, seconded by Harbinder Gill, **WLC 11/2023** That the transfer of Taxicab Plate #123 from The Estate of the late

Youssef Farhat to Amin Abdo Ahmed Al-Golfy **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- i. Amin Abdo Ahmed Al-Goly be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 150-2018 including a valid safety standards certificate.
- ii. Amin Abdo Ahmed Al-Goly be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a Taxicab Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee.
- iii. Amin Abdo Ahmed Al-Goly be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to provide verification that full compensation has been made to Mrs. Manal Al Hasan on behalf of The Estate of the late Youssef Farhat in consideration of the transfer of Taxicab plate #123.

- Abdelaziz Hassen be given sixty (60) days from the date of this decision to submit proof of an ownership of a vehicle and valid certificate of insurance that is satisfactory to Sections 4.2 and 9.1 of Schedule 3 to By-law 150-2018.
- The vehicle must submit to and pass an inspection by the By-law Enforcement Unit.

Licence Commissioner's Comments:

The attached applications were received by the Licensing Division from 1287609 Ontario Ltd. o/a Windsor Airline Limousine Services Ltd., Plate Holder of Taxicab Plate #049, and from Nadeem Qureshi for the prospective transfer of Taxicab Plate #049.

Regulatory Authority:

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 150-2018 states:

- "20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.
- 20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.
- 20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.
- 20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:
 - (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
 - (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner:
 - (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
 - (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed:
 - (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Further, Section 21.3 states:

"A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (I) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (a) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;

- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee;
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

Background:

The following is the chronology of events as it relates to the licence transfer request:

- September 21, 2023, transfer application and fee for taxicab plate #049 was submitted by 1287609 Ontario Ltd. o/a Windsor Airline Limousine Services Ltd, being Appendix "A"
- September 21, 2023, transferee application and proof of full-time status as a taxicab driver for Nadeem Qureshi was submitted, being Appendices "B" and "C".

Summary:

According to the AMANDA database, 1287609 Ontario Ltd. o/a Windsor Airline Limousine Services Ltd. has been the plate holder of taxicab plate #049 annually since 2007 and is therefore compliant with Section 20.1 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 150-2018.

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #049 be transferred to Nadeem Qureshi, who is currently not a licensed plate holder. Although Nadeem Qureshi does not hold a current place on the Drivers' List, he has provided proof that he has been employed as a full-time taxicab driver since April 2014, which satisfies the requirements of Section 20.4(a) of Schedule 5.

Nadeem Qureshi must provide:

- (a) Verification of an appropriate vehicle to which he will affix taxicab plate #049, including a valid safety standards certificate;
