C. Robertson advises that currently there are 2 Class "D" Livery Vehicles licensed in the City of Windsor and are within the thirty (30) vehicle limit contained in By-law 137-2007 (amended by By-law 138-2018).

WLC 6/2021 That the livery vehicle plate holder application, submitted by Mr. Wajid Farooq on behalf of St. Joachim Transport Services Inc., 843 County Road 2, Belle River, ON NOR 1A0, to operate one (1) Class "D" – Livery Vehicle, namely a 2016 Toyota Sienna (V.I.N. 5TDZK3DC4GS747289), **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

8. Reports & Administrative Matters

(a) Expired Application(s) for Business Licence

- J. Lesperance asks if Administration is seeing a trend in restaurant issues.
- C. Robertson responds the bylaw requires that the applicant submit requirements within 60 days from the date of application. Oftentimes, the licensee is not cooperating or unable to comply. During the pandemic there were some businesses that closed but there has not been a significant loss in licences or change in licensing. An expired application can be anything where the applicant was unable to submit the required documentation on time.
- G. Cian adds that some restaurants have not yet renewed their licences, however there has been a steady stream of those restaurants that have renewed their licences.

Councillor Kaschak refers to the restaurants operating from the WFCU Arena and notes it not been open due to the pandemic. He asks if Administration will follow-up with these restaurants.

- G. Cian remarks that Administration has been following up with enforcement and the Licensing staff has made contact with those parties.
- C. Robertson responds that expired applications can also mean a change in ownerships; licences are not transferable so if a business moves from one location to another, that would require a new application. As the sixty day deadline approaches, Administration works with the applicants to allow for the opportunity to comply with the requirements. The Licensing staff also notifies the applicants that their application is coming due and what is still outstanding.

Licence Commissioner's Comments:

The attached applications were received by the Licensing Division from Ms. Theresa Lamotte, Plate Holder of Taxicab #34, and from Mrs. Trivousa Shalaby for the prospective transfer of Taxicab Plate #34.

Regulatory Authority:

Schedule 5, Part VII, Section 20.1 through 20.4 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 (amended by By-law 150-2018) states:

- "20.1 Except as approved by the Licensing Commission, a taxicab plate holder may not transfer a taxicab plate and associated taxicab plate holder licence for a period of at least five (5) years from the date of issue of the licence.
- 20.2 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred without the approval of the Licensing Commission.
- 20.3 No taxicab plate holder licence shall be transferred until the person to whom the transfer is to be made has first received approval from the Licence Commissioner as a licensee.
- 20.4 Subject to the restrictions herein, taxicab plates numbered 001 to 224 are transferable, provided that:
 - (a) the transferee satisfies the eligibility criteria for inclusion on the Drivers' List;
 - (b) the transferee signs a form of statutory declaration prescribed by the Licence Commissioner:
 - (c) the transferor has completed a written application for the transfer in the prescribed form;
 - (d) the transferee satisfies the requirements of a taxicab plate holder under this By-law, including submitting for inspection the taxicab to which the plate will be affixed;
 - (e) the transferee pays all fees required under this By-law;

and the transferee will receive a taxicab plate holder licence at the time of transfer of the taxicab plate."

Further, Section 21.3 states:

"A taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle plate holder who has held a licence for a minimum of one (I) year may lease the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle licence on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis provided that:

- (h) the lessee is licensed by the City of Windsor as a taxicab driver;
- (b) all weekly, monthly or yearly leases are filed with and approved by the Licence Commissioner and shall be subject to such terms and conditions the Licence Commissioner may require;

- (c) the amount charged under the lease shall be a fair fee as approved by the Licence Commissioner and no additional charges shall be made against the lessee:
- (d) the lease agreement shall include a statement that the leasing agreement is considered null and void in the event that the lessor or lessee, either by written or verbal agreement, sub-leases the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle or transfers responsibility for the operation of the taxicab or taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicle to a third party;
- (e) the lease agreement shall contain a clearly-stated right of the lessor and lessee to early termination of the lease;
- (f) where the lessee is a corporation, the lessee shall, at the time at which the lease is filed with the Licence Commissioner in accordance with the provision of this section, file with the Licence Commissioner a form supplied by the Licence Commissioner and a copy of the lessee's articles of incorporation, amendment or amalgamation; and,
- (g) the lease term shall be a minimum of twelve (12) months and a maximum of twenty-four (24) months."

Background:

The following is the chronology of events as it relates to the licence transfer request:

- July 13, 2021, transfer application and fee for taxicab plate #34 was submitted on behalf of Ms. Theresa Lamotte, being Appendix "A"
- July 13, 2021, transferee application and proof of full-time status as a taxicab driver for Mrs. Trivousa Shalaby was submitted, being Appendices "B" and "C".

Summary:

According to the AMANDA database, Ms. Lamotte has been the plate holder of taxicab plate #34 annually since at least 1998 and is therefore compliant with Section 20.1 to Public Vehicle Licensing By-Law 137-2007 (amended by By-law 150-2018).

It is being requested that Taxicab Plate #34 be transferred to Mrs. Trivousa Shalaby, who is currently not a licensed plate holder. Although Mrs. Shalaby does not hold a current place on the Drivers' List, she has provided proof that she has been employed as a full-time taxicab driver since March 12, 2019, which satisfies the requirements of Section 20.4(a) of Schedule 5.

Mrs. Trivousa Shalaby must provide:

- (a) Verification of an appropriate vehicle to which she will affix taxicab plate #34, including a valid safety standards certificate;
- (b) A completed Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee;
- (c) Verification that full compensation has been made to Ms. Theresa Lamotte in consideration of the transfer of taxicab plate #34

Recommendation:

To the Windsor Licensing Commission for decision on the following:

THAT the transfer of Taxicab Plate #34 from Ms. Theresa Lamotte to Mrs. Trivousa Shalaby **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

- i. Mrs. Shalaby be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a vehicle for inspection that complies with Schedule 5 to By-law 137-2007 (amended by By-law 150-2018), including a valid safety standards certificate.
- ii. Mrs. Shalaby be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to submit a Taxicab Plate Holder application and pay the associated fee.
- iii. Mrs. Shalaby be given thirty (30) days from the date of the approval to provide verification that full compensation has been made to Ms. Theresa Lamotte in consideration of the transfer of Taxicab plate #34.
- iv. Mrs. Shalaby shall not lease Taxicab plate #34 for a one year period as stated in Schedule 5, Section 21.3 of Licensing By-law 137-2007 (amended by By-law 150-2018).

Licence Commissioner's Comments:

A new application for a Salvage Yard licence was submitted on March 23, 2021 by Mr. Mohsen Farahat of 2207113 Ontario Inc. o/a Downtown Auto Center, 100-1153 Tecumseh Road West, Windsor. The Licensing Division records show that this corporation is also currently licensed to operate as an Automobile Service Station, for both Repairs and Storage/Sales, at 939 Giles Boulevard West. Administration feels it is

necessary to inform the Windsor Licensing Commission that in November 2017, the aforementioned Automobile Service Station licences associated with this same licensee were suspended as a result of a Commission decision 8/2017 for a period of thirteen (13) days, due to several complaints pertaining to the condition of the property.

Regulatory Authority:

Every application will be subject to investigations approvals from such municipal or provincial departments or agencies as the Licence Commissioner deems necessary, or as directed by the Windsor Licensing Commission, including but not limited to: Police Services, Windsor/Essex County Health Unit, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Building and Development Department, Environmental Services Department and Licensing and Enforcement Department.

Section 1 of Schedule S1 to Licensing By-law 395-2004 states:

- 1. In the case of an application for a licence for a salvage yard, the Licence Commissioner or designate shall:
 - (1) cause notice to be mailed by regular mail to the owners of all lands lying within three hundred feet (300') of the salvage yard, inviting their comments at least I5 days prior to the date the Licence Commissioner considers the application.
 - (2) If an objection is received from persons entitled to notice, the Licence Commissioner shall refer the application to the Windsor Licensing Commission, provided that such notice shall not be necessary where the application is for renewal of a licence held for the previous year.

Further, the general provisions, section 3.24 states:

- (h) the premises in which the business is located shall be in accordance with the requirements of the *Building Code Act* and the Regulations there under, the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act*, and the Regulations there under, and any by-law of the City prescribing standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property within the City;
- (i) where premises in which the business is located are altered and a building permit is required to carry out the alterations, the premises, as altered, shall be in accordance with the *Building Code Act* and the Regulations there under, the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act*, and the Regulations there under, the Regulations falling within the jurisdiction of the Medical Officer of Health, and any by-law of the City prescribing standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property within the City;

Background:

The following is the chronology of events as it relates to the licence application:

- February 3, 2021, a building use complaint is filed with 311 with respect to an "acrid/burning smell coming from one of the rear buildings".
- March 3, 2021, Building By-law Enforcement Officer Dante Lapico attends the property and observes "a very large stack of wood pallets, old tires, drums of what looked like was oil and vehicles/parts onsite".
- March 23, 2021, an application for the abovementioned Salvage Yard licence is submitted by Mr. Farahat on behalf of 2207113 Ontario Inc. o/a Downtown Auto Center.
- May 27, 2021, By-law Enforcement Officer Andrew Wong attends the property and notes that the surrounding chain-link fence enclosure did not have proper screening, allowing an unobstructed view of the salvage yard, contrary to Schedule S1, Section 4.
- July 19, 2021, Building By-law Officer Lapico re-attends the property and notes the operation of a salvage/heavy auto repair garage in the south portion of the property as well as several dozen inoperable vehicles located on the property. This activity was not permitted through a building permit, or a site plan control agreement. An order was issued to remove all vehicles, parts, and cease the noted operations until all proper approvals were obtained.
- July 22, 2021, in accordance with Schedule S1 of Business Licensing By-law 395-2004, a total of 23 letters of notification are sent to all property owners of lands lying within three hundred feet (300') of the proposed Salvage Yard with a deadline of August 5, 2021 to submit a response.
- July 29 through August 12, 2021, a total of six (6) objections to a Salvage Yard of any kind and one (1) objection to an outdoor Salvage Yard are received by neighbouring property owners or their agent(s).

Summary:

The Commission will recall that it has the right to revoke, suspend or place conditions on a business licence when it feels a licensee is likely to breach the law or it is not within the public interest to permit the licence to go forward. In this case, the licensee is currently not in compliance with numerous requirements from various departments and administration has received six (6) objections from neighbouring land owners.

Administration is not opposed to the issuance of this licence but, based on the history of the licensee, the current non-compliant matters and public objections received, it is being recommended that should the application be approved, that the Windsor Licensing Commission impose certain conditions on the licence in order to protect the public.

Recommendation:

THAT the application for a Salvage Yard licence submitted by, Mr. Mohsen Farahat of 2207113 Ontario Inc. o/a Downtown Auto Center, 100-1153 Tecumseh Road West, Windsor **BE APPROVED** with the following conditions:

The applicant be given sixty (60) days from the date of this Decision to:

- comply with the non compliant matters to the satisfaction of the Chief Building Official and Licence Commissioner inclusive of obtaining the required building permits and/or site plan control agreement;
- bring the fence and property conditions into compliance with by-law standards;
- submit to and pass an inspection by the Pollution Control Department.

AND;

THAT the application for a Salvage Yard licence submitted by, Mr. Mohsen Farahat of 2207113 Ontario Inc. o/a Downtown Auto Center, 100-1153 Tecumseh Road West, Windsor **BE REFUSED** should the applicant fail to comply within the sixty (60) day deadline.

AND FURTHER;

THAT upon the issuance of a Salvage Yard licence to 2207113 Ontario Inc. o/a Downtown Auto Center, located at 100-1153 Tecumseh Road West, any substantiated complaints or violations as it relates to the non compliant matters and citizen concerns identified at this hearing will result that the licence **BE SUSPENDED** until the next scheduled hearing of the Windsor Licensing Commission.
