	With this enhancement, customers will have coverage for production loss due to labour disruptions caused by COVID-19 for the full duration of their 2020 policies, from when the crop is planted all the way to harvest. For perennials, coverage starts at the beginning of the coverage period.		
Special Conditions:	If customers have crop losses at the time of harvest and the cause is on-farm labour disruptions due to COVID-19, they need to call Agricorp at 1-888-247-4999 to report the crop loss.		
	Customers will be expected to have implemented health and safety management practices recommended by public health guidelines, including measures such as distancing and personal protective equipment.
