Description:	<p>From March 30, 2020 to September 30, 2020, qualified recipients will not be required to make any loan payments, and interest will not accrue student loans.</p> <p>During this deferral:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • payments will not be withdrawn from students' account if they are on pre-authorized debit • if students make payments through online banking or cheque, they are not required to send in payments due during this period 	

	Students can still make one-time payments online if you want to repay your loan faster. Payments during this period will go entirely towards your loan principal.
Special Conditions:	If you are a full-time student making your first OSAP application for the 2020-21 school year, you'll need to complete a short information session presented just before you start your application.
