Fat. Oil & Grease (FOG)

Sewer lines clogged with a build up of wipes, personal care products, and FOG contribute to sewer backups.

Human waste and toilet paper are the only materials that should be flushed down the toilet.

The City of Windsor needs everyone to do their part to help maintain the sewer system to prevent costly excess repairs and maintenance and reduce the risk of basement flooding.

Did you know? The City is responsible for maintenance of over 1,700 km of sewer pipes.

How to properly dispose of wipes?

All wipes, paper towels must be placed in the garbage for disposal. Only toilet paper can be flushed in the toilet.
