4. **BUSINESS ITEMS**

4.1 2016 United Nations Day of the Elder Person

The following comments are provided relating to the 2016 United Nations Day of the Elder Persons:

- The organizing committee is comprised of several seniors' organizations, i.e. SAC, CARP, Life After Fifty, Local Retiree union groups.
- The UN Day of the Elder Persons has been adopted as National Seniors Day.
- The 2015 event was held in City Hall Square and a set-up fee of \$365 was charged to the organizers.
- Request for Mayor Dilkens to issue a Proclamation for this event and for SAC to act as lead for the set-up of the event.
- Suggestion for SAC to actively participate in concert with the organizing committee as a catalyst and advocate.
- Suggestion to change the venue to the WFCU Centre
- Historically, the event has been held at City Hall Square and rental of All Saints Church was procured as a default in the event of inclement weather.
- It is generally agreed the event to be non-partisan and inclusive.

In commemoration of the UN International Day of Elder Persons and National Seniors Day to be held on October 1, 2016, the Seniors Advisory Committee requests the following:

- That Mayor Dilkens **BE REQUESTED** to issue a proclamation for the **UN** International Day of Elder Persons and National Seniors Day; and
- That the Seniors Advisory Committee BE REQUESTED to submit an application for facility rental of an area located in City Hall Square for the October 1, 2016 event, and

 That facility rental fees for the set-up of the event BE WAIVED, and failing that, that APPROVAL BE GIVEN to an expenditure in the upset amount of \$500 (from the SAC 2016 Operating Budget) for costs associated with the event.

4.2 <u>Lower the Currently Identified Age of 65 Years for a Senior within the</u> Corporation of the City of Windsor

- S. Bisson advises the Corporation has established the age of 60 years "for a senior" as it relates to the Transit Windsor and the Recreation and Culture Departments. The report of the Coordinator of Community Development regarding this matter is distributed and <u>attached</u> as Appendix "A".
- C. Southward indicates many agencies recognize a senior as one who is 55 years of age.
