Our thanks to Jeannette for hosting us at Amy's Helping Hands and for providing a tour of their facilities and explanation of their manifold services for seniors.

The budget item was deferred.

The AFW Project Update was provided by email by Jill as she was ill. The 'Network' continues to meet monthly and all SAC members can attend. Current focus is on developing Network TOR and membership, and cooperating with Administration's timely input into the Action Plan as directed by Council respecting SAC deadline of June to submit the Action Plan to WHO. CARP was promoted to join the Network.

Most of the meeting was given over to discussing our 2014 Annual Plan proposal to organize a 'Provincial AFC Seniors Summit'. Beyond agreement to pursue such an ambitious undertaking there was agreement to look for partners particularly those which might share in some of the related funding needs. Among possible such partners could be OCSCO (a provincial seniors organization with a strong mandate to promote educational projects), the Ontario Seniors Secretariat, and local partners like LAF and ElderCollege.

Other items were deferred due to lack of time.
