Mandate and Terms of Reference – 2023-2026

Mandate

- The Transit Windsor Working Group will provide advice on:
- Policies and procedures with respect to the operation of conventional transit services in Windsor
- The extent of service hours and days of operation
- Operational rules and regulations relating to transit services
- The Transit Windsor Working Group will act in an advisory role to the Environment, Transportation and Public Safety Standing Committee, City Council and Transit administration.
- To provide feedback and input on service development and improvements.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Review proposed service changes for feedback
- Make suggestions for future service improvements
- Provide feedback on current operations and fare policies and suggested changes for same
- Provide feedback on customer-related policies/procedures

Composition/Membership

The working group will consist of six (6) members, consisting of one representative of University of Windsor Students Association, one from the St. Clair College Student Representative Council, one representing secondary school students, one representing seniors, and two from the general community.

Additional Information

The Transit Windsor Working Group will meet quarterly.

Remuneration

Members will serve in a volunteer capacity with no remuneration.
