The Chair calls the meeting to order at 5:03 o'clock p.m. and the Committee considers the Agenda being Schedule "A" **attached** hereto, matters which are dealt with as follows:

4. **BUSINESS ITEMS**

4.1 **Bike to Work Event and Bike Commuter of the Year Award**

The Chairperson reports the Bike to Work event will be held on May 31, 2013. The ride will begin at the WFCU Centre at 6:45 a.m.; will proceed on the Ganatchio Trail; then along the Riverfront Trail arriving at the CBC on Riverside and Crawford at approximately 8:00 a.m. for breakfast. The first 50 participants to arrive at the CBC will receive a Bike to Work Windsor t-shirt, donated by J&R Sports Connection.

The Chairperson states bicycle commuters (new or seasoned) are encouraged to submit in writing their experience riding the commuter trails and may possibly win a new bike and a commemorative plaque. The winner will be announced at the Bike to Work breakfast to be held on May 31, 2013 at CBC.

connects Windsor to the Quebec Border. She advises on August 11, 2013 the members
may ride from Lakeshore to Windsor or, on August 12, 2013 the WBC may cycle from
Windsor to Leamington.

In terms of the Rediscover Your Bike event, C. Copot-Nepszy states the event will be held on June 22, 2013 from 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. at Remington Park. She requests WBC members assist with bicycle safety checks.

The Chairperson states the City is considering the closure of the riverfront trail near the Festival Plaza during the summer months.

Dr. Waters notes there is a wrap-around near the Festival Plaza so cyclists can still cycle on the trails. J. Leitzinger to investigate and report back.

The next meeting will be held on July 24, 2013 at 5:00 o'clock p.m. in Room 407, 400 City Hall Square East.

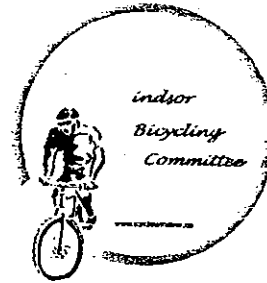
