

2. BACKGROUND:

The Parkway Infrastructure Contractors will be reducing E.C. Row between Ojibway Parkway & Huron Church Road Interchange to one lane (in each direction). The E.C. Row lane reduction will be in place for a two year duration.

In consultation with City and County emergency services, the Ministry of Transportation and various City Administration, the Parkway Infrastructure Contractors developed a "Traffic Management and Incident Response Plan for the E.C. Row Crossover and lane Re-Configuration" dated October 19, 2012.

3. DISCUSSION:

The above mentioned plan includes section 10.2 Permanently Trail-blazed Route (TBR) and reads as follows:

Should an incident/emergency occur on E.C. Row Expressway between Ojibway Parkway and Huron Church Road, or a closure is required, a permanent Trail-blazed route (TBR), agreed upon with City of Windsor Police(CWP) & Ontario Provincial Police(OPP) will be used. The TBR plan including the various locations for deployment of police cruisers is included..."

The TBR plan attached as Schedule A shows the Permanently Trail-blazed Route. The designated alternate route for E.C. Row westbound traffic is Tecumseh Road West towards Prince Road. It should be noted that this section of Tecumseh Road and Prince Road are not established truck routes. Should a full closure occur, various police personnel will be located to monitor traffic flow at key points.

4. RISK ANALYSIS:

Likelihood of trail blaze route to be used – Rare to Possible

Consequences of Damage & Liability - Medium Risk

As traffic must be maintained and the number of occurrences is expected to be small, the risk is deemed acceptable.










STAGING AREA FOR EMS & FIRE
