BY-LAW NUMBER 7635

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR A DRAINAGE WORKS IN THE CITY OF WINDSOR IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX.

WHEREAS Section 1 of the City of Windsor Act S.O. 1968-69, provides that where the Council of The Corporation deems it expedient to undertake the construction, repair or improvement of any drainage works in the City of Windsor or any defined area thereof, in accordance with the provisions of the Drainage Act 1962-63 it may, not withstanding that Act, by by-law provide that the whole or such part as the by-law may determine, of the cost of such construction, repair or improvement shall be charged and collected by a special rate sufficient therefore levied upon all the rateable property in the City of Windsor or in any such defined area.

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Windsor has procured a report made by E.O. LaFontaine, P. Eng., and the report is attached hereto and forms part of this by-law.

AND WHEREAS the estimated total cost of constructing the drainage works is \$2,400,000.00.

AND WHEREAS the Council is of the opinion that the drainage of the area is desirable.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Windsor under the Drainage Act, enacts as follows:

- 1. The report dated 1983 06 24 and attached hereto is hereby adopted and the drainage works as therein indicated and set forth is hereby authorized and shall be completed in accordance therewith.
- 2. (1) The Corporation of the City of Windsor may borrow on the credit of the Corporation the amount of \$2,400,000.00 being the amount necessary for the construction of the drainage works.
 - (2) The Corporation may issue debentures for the amount borrowed less the total amount of,
 - (a) grants received under Section 85 of the Act, and
 - (b) monies received from the Essex Region Conservation Authority,

and such debentures shall be made payable within 20 years from the date of the debenture and shall bear interest at a rate not higher than the rate charged by The Ontario Municipal Improvement Corporation on the date of sale of such debenture.

- 3. A special equal annual rate sufficient to redeem the principal and interest on the debentures shall be levied upon the whole rateable property in the City of Windsor in each year for 20 years after the passing of this by-law to be collected in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are collected.
- 4. This by-law comes into force on the passing thereof and may be cited as Little River Drain Dike Repairs and Improvements Bylaw.
