# LEAMINGTON EMERGENCY SHELTER PROGRAM

#### **Program Overview**

The Leamington Emergency Shelter Program provides short term accommodations for eligible households experiencing homelessness. Shelter support services and housing assistance will be provided by staff located in Leamington.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

All households must have the ability to stay safely in a motel room without 24/7 supervision, and one of more of the following:

- Employment in Leamington area
- Children are enrolled in nearby school
- Vital connection to services or supports in Learnington (i.e.: frequent doctor's appointments)

## Referrals

Staff are available from 10am-6pm to accept self referrals and direct referrals from shelters, social services, hospitals, police, and community agencies.
