COST ESTIMATE

- Either option is estimated to cost approximately the same
 - Option A Approximately \$2,600,000
 - Bike lanes on both sides
 - Completion of the missing sidewalk sections on both sides
 - Option B Approximately \$2,620,000
 - Multi-use trail on one side
 - Completion of the missing sidewalk sections on the other side

Note:

- Cost estimate does not include detailed design, contract administration, contingency, survey, inspection or CCTV



Bike Lanes and a Multi-Use Trail on the south side of Todd Lane, from Tenth Street westerly.




MTO-Assumed Right of Way
