YES, "you" can <u>see</u> it.... BUT can "we" <u>read</u> it???



This permit is valid when used only by the person to whom it is issued. If the holder of this permit is deceased or no longer has a disability, the permit expires immediately and must be returned to ServiceOntario.

The permit must be placed face up on the dashboard or attached to the turned down sun visor. Permit number, identification number and validity dates must be clearly visible from outside the vehicle. To make sure we can read it, take a few moments to look back and make sure you can see the entire permit. If you can't see all four corners of the permit, the officers aren't able to see them either. Please make sure your permit is completely visible or you may be subject to a Penalty Notice (Parking Ticket).

If you are seen misusing an Accessible Parking Permit, you are subject to fines up to \$5000. If the permit is not your permit, DO NOT USE IT!! You may be taking the spot of someone who needs it!
