

BY-LAW NUMBER 80-2019

A BY-LAW TO REQUIRE THAT ALL RETAIL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS
IN THE CITY OF WINDSOR BE CLOSED ON CHRISTMAS DAY, DECEMBER
25th

Passed the 17th day of June, 2019.

WHEREAS Section 148(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, provides that the council of a municipality may by by-law require that retail business establishments be closed to the public at any time;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Windsor has determined that all retail business establishments are required to be closed on the holiday of Christmas Day, December 25th,

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Windsor enacts as follows:

1. In this by-law,
 - (a) **"exemptions"** means
 - (i) goods or services in the form of or in connection with prepared meals or living accommodation;
 - (ii) liquor under the authority of a licence or permit issued under the *Liquor Licence Act*;
 - (iii) any other prescribed goods or services; and
 - (c) **"retail business establishment"** means the premises where goods or services are sold or offered for sale by retail.
2. That all retail business establishments in the City of Windsor shall be closed to the public on Christmas Day, December 25th.
3. This by-law does not apply to the sale or offering for sale by retail of the exemptions.
3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
