BRAIN INJURY AWARENESS MONTH JUNE 2019


- WHEREAS:** Approximately 1.5 million people in Canada are living with a brain injury (ABI) and statistics indicate that 100,000 Canadians will experience a brain injury each year. The annual cost of ABI has been estimated at \$3 billion; and
- WHEREAS:** In Ontario there are almost a half a million people living with a brain injury and 18,000 new cases are added every year. The annual cost of ABI in Ontario is \$1 billion; and
- WHEREAS:** Brain injury is the leading cause of death and disability for Canadians under the age of 40.
- WHEREAS:** Our mission is to bring awareness of the prevalence of brain injury in our community, support those affected by a brain injury and educate about the prevention of brain injury; and
