PROCLAMATION

"HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE DAY"

APRIL 28, 2019

- WHEREAS:** The citizens of Windsor join with the Jewish Community of Windsor to commemorate the Shoah, the Holocaust, and the millions of lives lost in Europe during the Second World War, and recognize the long established Jewish Community in Windsor and re-dedicate ourselves to never allow a re-occurrence of the Holocaust; and
- WHEREAS:** Communities throughout the world have proclaimed the 28th of April as a day of remembrance for those who died or suffered in internment camps during World War II; and
- WHEREAS:** We wish to remember the people, communities, places of worship and other institutions destroyed in the attempt to erase forever the faith and culture of a part of our human race; and
- WHEREAS:** We wish to pay tribute to the heroism of the underground fighters in the ghettos, those interred in concentration camps, and servicemen and women everywhere;
