
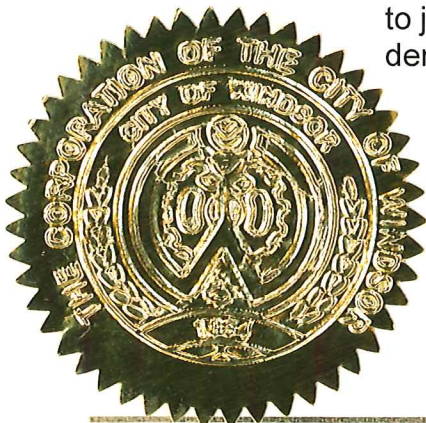
PROCLAMATION
