
PROCLAMATION

“World Pancreatic Cancer Day” NOVEMBER 21, 2019

- WHEREAS:** In 2019, an estimated 5,800 people will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in Canada and 92 percent will eventually die from the disease;
- WHEREAS:** Pancreatic cancer has the lowest survival rate of all major cancers, and just 8 percent of those diagnosed survive five years or longer;
- WHEREAS:** Pancreatic cancer is the now the third leading cause of cancer related death in Canada;
- WHEREAS:** It is estimated that by 2020, 480,000 new cases will be diagnosed globally;
- WHEREAS:** The good health and well-being of the residents of Windsor are enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about the risks and symptoms of pancreatic cancer, and research into early detection, causes, and effective treatments; and
