EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

2. BACKGROUND:

On September 14, 2009 City Council approved the agreement with the Province of Ontario for funding the After School Initiative in designated neighbourhoods as one of the pilot cities across the province. This funding has allowed the Department of Recreation and Culture to provide after school programming from October of 2009 to June of 2012 at no cost to the participants. In that time period over 100 youth in each school calendar year were able to access after school services that provided education on healthy living, a healthy after school snack and a variety of physical activity programming opportunities.

In July of 2012 the Province announced funding for the upcoming 2012-2013 school calendar year and requested existing providers of the After School Initiative to submit applications for renewal. The Department of Recreation and Culture submitted the required application for renewal on August 3, 2012 and has been granted funding to continue to provide the After School

Programming Initiative for the 2012-2013 school calendar year at Windsor Water World, Adie Knox Herman Recreation Complex and the Gino and Liz Marcus Community Centre.

3. DISCUSSION:

The Community Development and Health Commissioner and the City Clerk will sign the renewal agreement for the 2012-2013 school calendar year with the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport as authorized by motion M155-2011, granted that the agreement is satisfactory in technical content to the Executive Director of Recreation and Culture, in financial content to the City Treasurer and in form to the City Solicitor.

The Ministry did not require a new agreement to be signed. The CAO signed the application.



7. CONCLUSION:


