

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: N/A

2. BACKGROUND:

Council passed Motion M204-2011 on August 29, 2011 stating:

"That the Seniors Advisory Committee (S.A.C.) SUBMIT an application for the "New Horizons for Seniors Program Community Participation and Leadership Funding Grant Application/Agreement", provided by Human Resources and Skills Development Canada, by September 16, 2011; and that the Mayor and CAO BE AUTHORIZED to sign the application."

3. DISCUSSION:

Two applications were submitted to Toronto for the same 'Call for Proposals' to the New Horizons for Seniors Program in October from the Seniors Advisory Committee and the

Recreation and Culture Department. In liaison with the Toronto Office, the City of Windsor is only eligible for a maximum ask of \$25,000.00.

In the essence of time and with the goal of not ruining the integrity of either application, the SAC agreed to hold off on their application and allow the Recreation and Culture Grant to proceed. The SAC will re-submit the same application at the next 'Call for Proposals'. The SAC has been heavily committed to the Age Friendly project and would be challenged to ensure adequate resources were available for a new project.

4. FINANCIAL MATTERS:

The Seniors Advisory Committee will re-submit the same grant application entitled Seniors' Summit to the New Horizons for Seniors Program for \$24,900.00.

5. CONSULTATIONS:



Larry Duffield, Chair of the Seniors Advisory Committee and Jan Wilson, Executive Director, Recreation and Culture were both consulted.

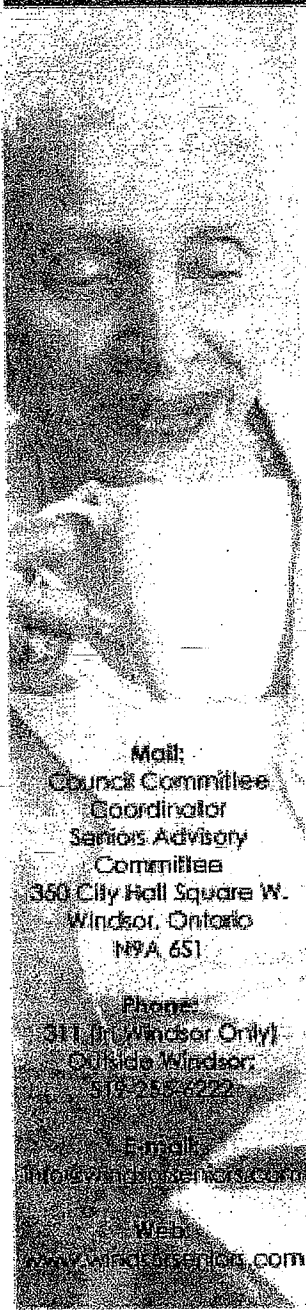
