

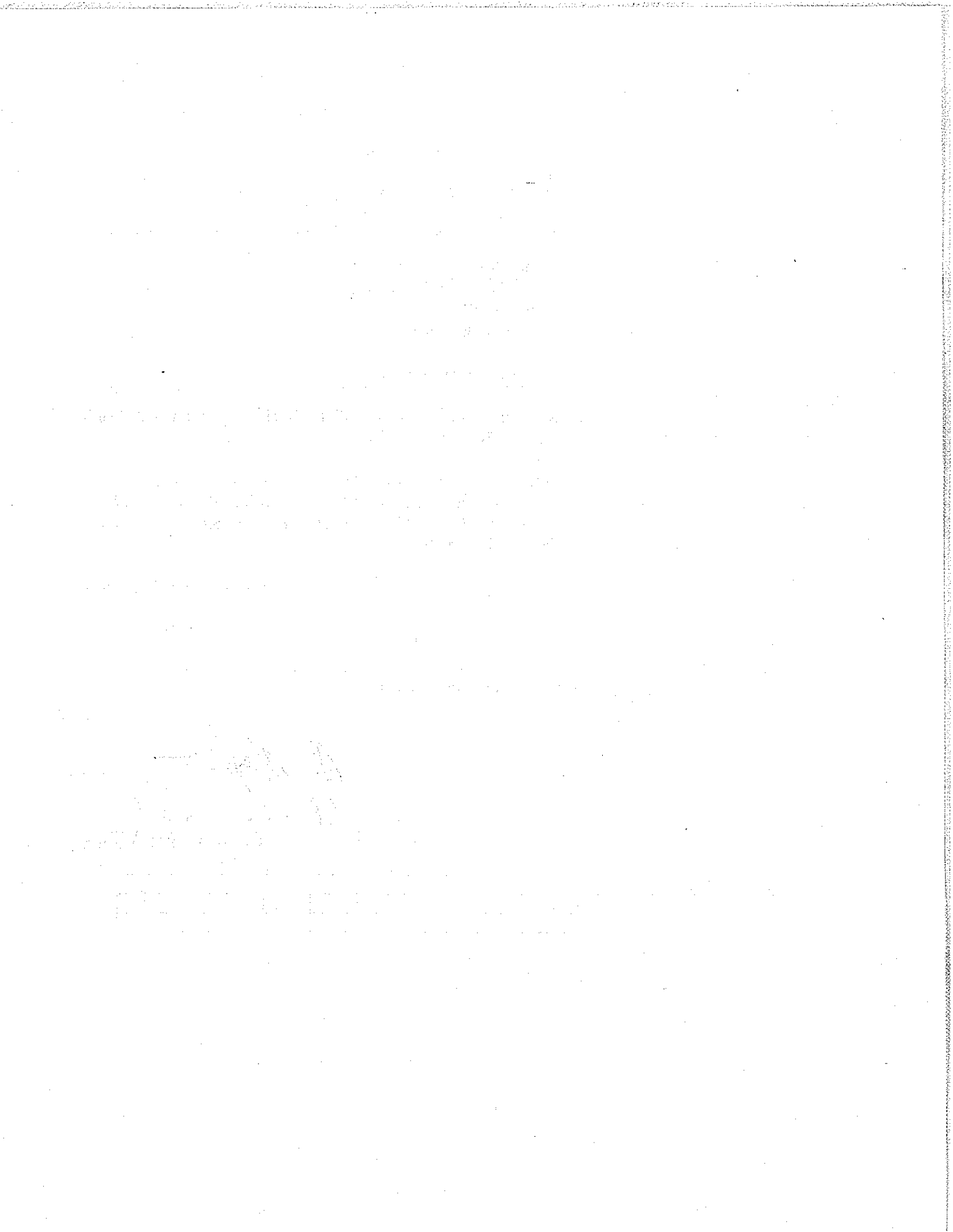

2. BACKGROUND:

At the Council meeting on October 17th, 2011, Councillor Jones asked the following question:

CQ66-2011

"Asks that Administration look at the appropriate agencies and funding sources to see if artwork at the tunnel exit/entrance be put on the walls to depict history of City of Windsor – i.e. Rumrunners, Underground Railroad, automotive industry, Battle of 1812."

SR2011 (October 17, 2011)

3. DISCUSSION:

City staff called Mr. Galvin, General Manager of the Windsor-Detroit Tunnel Corporation to discuss possible location of murals. Mr. Galvin determined that the location of the murals would be on private property not owned by the City of Windsor.

Further conversation indicated that other potential locations of murals in the tunnel would not be possible due to the restrictions required for safe visibility of traffic flow as regulated by Transportation Canada.

City staff determined that due to Federal Transportation regulations and private property issues, it is not possible to install artwork at the tunnel exit/entrance, therefore pursuing the request to discover alternative funding sources should not be contemplated at this time.




