

**Re: Corporation of the City of Windsor
Investment in Affordable Housing (IAH) for Ontario program
Year 1 (2011-12) Business Case Approval – Operating Components**

In response to the business case you submitted on September 30, 2011, the ministry is approving the provision of funding in the amount of \$642,600, under the rent supplement component for Year 1 (2011-12) of the Investment in Affordable Housing for Ontario program, in the City of Windsor area.

The ministry intends to allow program expenses incurred after Service Managers sign their Notice of Intent as eligible expenses for the purpose of reporting and reconciliation of Year 1 program costs. This means that if a Service Manager signed the Notice of Intent on October 1st, program costs incurred on and after that date will be considered to be allowable expenses, providing the Service Manager signs the Administration Agreement with the Province of Ontario and otherwise meets the eligible expense criteria of the program. Note that Service Managers who incur costs prior to and without signing the Agreement are doing so at their own risk. Even if these costs meet program criteria, the ministry will not reimburse them should the Service Manager not sign the Administration Agreement.

Please note that all Year 1 funding must be committed by March 31, 2012. Committed is defined as the Service Manager entering into a funding/subsidy agreement with a landlord and/or client. Service Managers that cannot meet this timeline may have their funding re-allocated.
