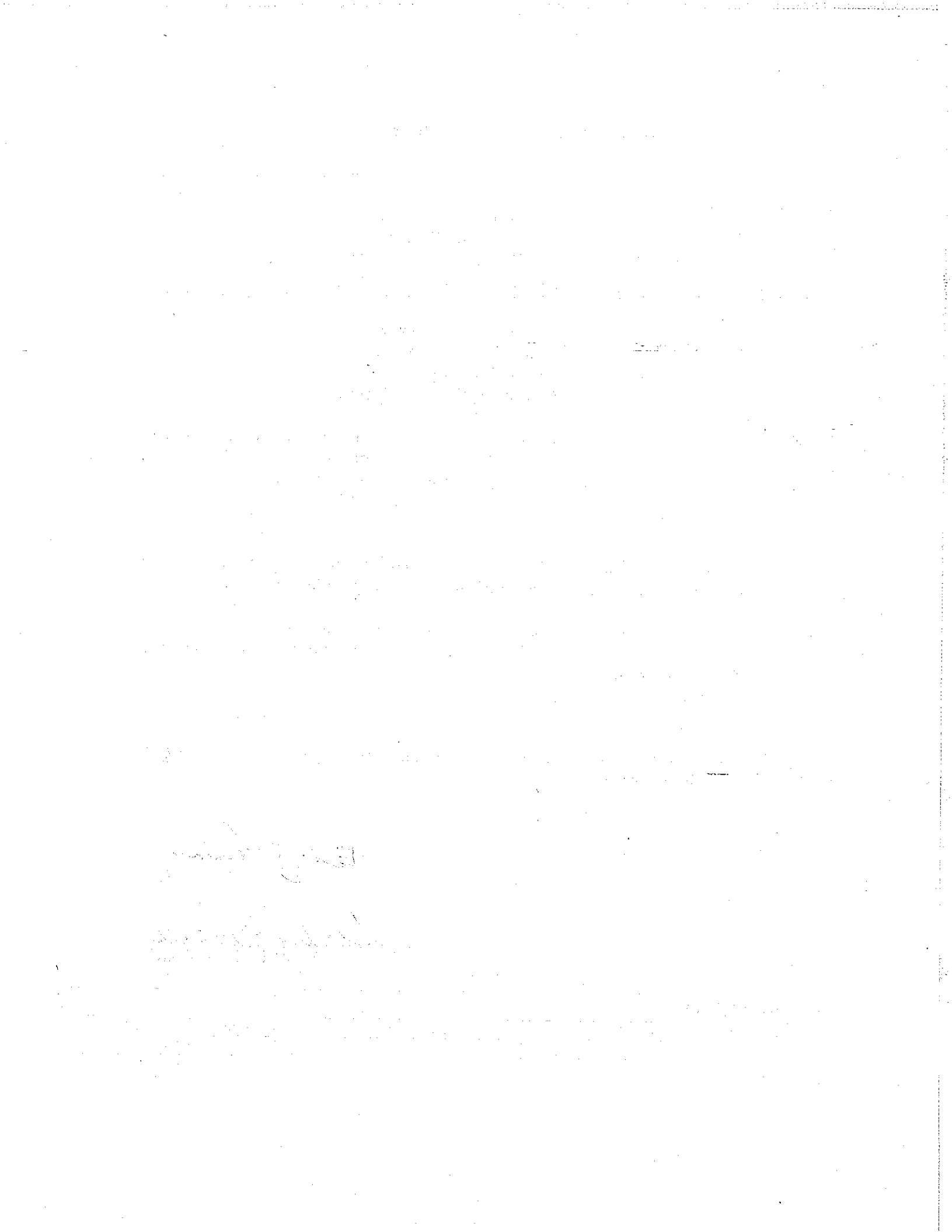

The Windsor Accessibility Advisory Committee had the opportunity to contribute input and expertise regarding the proposal of Councillor Jones to provide funding from the Enhanced Capital Budget Ward Priority Fund to create an accessible park and improve upon the accessibility of a number of curb cuts in Ward 2. A number of members of the Committee have been involved with providing input on the importance and technical requirements required for accessible curb ramps. The Committee is extremely pleased that Councillor Jones would like to donate a portion of funds to help support the retrofit of a number of curbs that are currently lacking in his ward.

Additionally, the Windsor Accessibility Advisory Committee fully supports the plan to create an accessible Paterson Park. The Committee was so pleased with the plans and proposal that it also chose to recommend the additional donation of \$40,000 from the WAAC Accessible Built Environment Capital Fund to ensure that all of the required accessibility amenities could be realized. This park fulfills specific accessibility needs which have been brought to the attention of Councillor Jones. This approach of listening to the needs of persons with disabilities and then seeking additional advice and input from the Advisory Committee is helping to ensure a park space that will need the needs of the Community.
