That the following recommendation of the Social Development, Health and Culture Standing Committee **BE APPROVED** as follows:



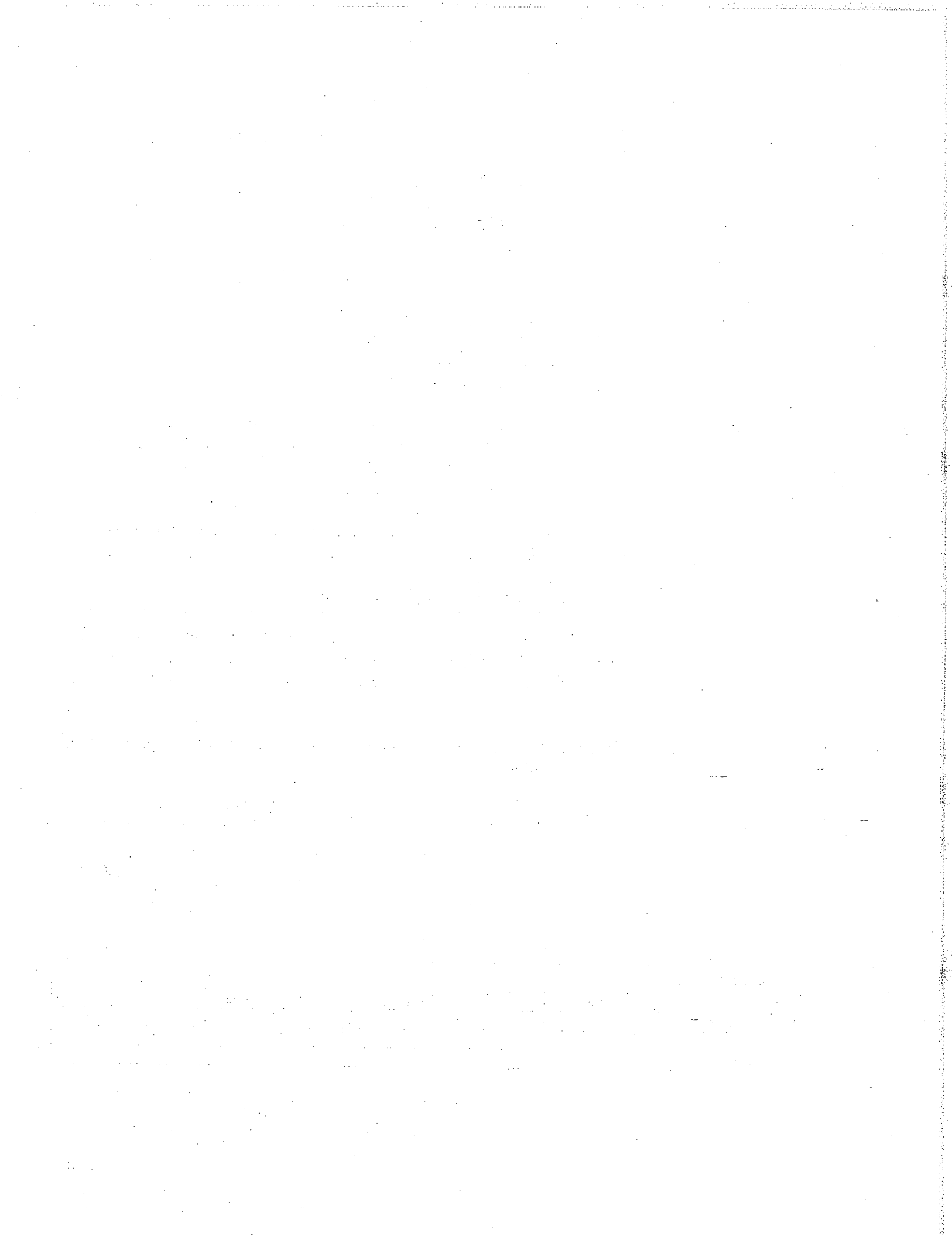

1) Description of Barrier Removal Project and how it promotes universal access to all persons with disabilities (include appropriate references to attitudinal, informational, physical, technological, architectural or policy barriers):

The project involves the installation of Audible Pedestrian Signals (APS) to assist the visually impaired in knowing when they are able to cross the street at signalized intersections. In 2016, under AODA, when over 50% of pedestrian signals are to be replaced at a signalized intersection, installation of APS will become mandatory. Historically, the CNIB has brought forward locations which they believe would benefit from the installation of APS and several locations have APS installed. The request before you is for two locations which the CNIB has brought forward for the installation of APS.

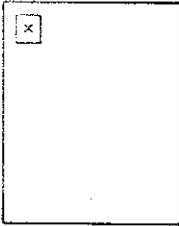
