Starting September 2025, Transit Windsor will be transitioning to regular public bus routes for all students that have been using the secondary school extras. This change will affect students attending Riverside Secondary School, Vincent Massey Secondary School, Holy Names Catholic High School, and St. Joseph's Catholic High School. This transition is designed to integrate school transportation into the broader public transit system, providing students with greater independence, flexibility, and access to a wide range of transit services throughout the city.
