PLANNING BACKGROUND

- An Environmental Assessment (EA) of the Cabana/Division Rd. corridor was completed in November 2005.
- This corridor had been identified as a priority in both the Windsor Area Long-range Transportation Study (WALTS) and the Bicycle Use Master Plan.
- The Cabana Rd. corridor is the only continuous east-west arterial roadway in South Windsor and is identified as part of the 'Windsor' Loop' bicycle route in BUMP
- The intersections of Cabana at Howard and Cabana at Provincial Rd. (including the at-grade railway crossing) were completed as part of the implementation of the preferred plan from the EA
- Cabana Road East was constructed between Provincial Road and Howard Avenue as part of the implementation of the preferred plan from the Cabana / Division Corridor EA.

BRIEF HISTORY PLANNING BACKGROUND AND PREFERRED PLAN

Between Howard and Dougall, the preferred plan has the following

A four lane undivided roadway with bicycle lanes, curbs and gutters, and sidewalks on both sides;

Two potential road closures in the area of Huntington Ave. and Ouellette Ave. were identified in the EA. As well, the EA identified the potential closure of Roseland Cres. right of way on the south

The EA noted mixed sentiments among residents and stakeholders

Reducing traffic conflicts along Cabana to both cars and

Reducing traffic infiltration or cut-through traffic;

Inconvenience to some residents gaining access to Cabana

Concerns about emergency response by first-responders.

The EA concluded that proposed closure should be examined more




The work plan calls for this PIC to receive feedback on the potential road closure prior to completion of the final design.















PROPOSED CABANA ROAD CROSS-SECTION EXISTING CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY

• The project team met with Emergency Services (Police, Fire and EMS) to discuss possible closure scenarios;

• Traffic volumes are extremely low, such that any street closure will not have detrimental traffic operations impact, one way or

• It is desirable to enhance traffic, pedestrian and bicycle operational safety on Cabana by minimizing local street intersection

• The potential closure of Ouellette Ave. was screened out for emergency response concerns, since the cul-de-sac would exceed the recommended maximum cul-de-sac length and number of units served by a single point of access;

• A review of network connectivity of each street within the local neighbourhood shows that unlike Huntington with three direct connections to Dougall Ave. at Granada Ave. E., Medina St. E. and Beal St. E., Inglewood has no such a connection to

• Leaving Inglewood open and closing Huntington was the preferred access as per EA;


