The City of Windsor will be resurfacing Halpin Road from Mulberry Road to Wildwood Drive. This work will start **November 6, 2018**, weather permitting. "No Parking" signs will be posted the night before work will start.

**PLEASE REMOVE YOUR VEHICLE FROM THE ROAD BY 7:00 A.M. THE  
MORNING AFTER SIGNS ARE POSTED SO THAT WORK CAN START.**

The work will consist of removal and replacement of the asphalt pavement. During the course of construction, there will short periods of time when driveways will not be accessible.

During the period of time between when the old pavement has been removed, and paving of the new asphalt, there will be a 100mm - 125mm drop at driveways. This condition will only exist until the base asphalt has been placed.

Please be aware that a surface treatment is used prior to paving that would likely be carried by your car tires onto your driveway if you choose to drive through the area during this work. It is recommended that you try to avoid using the road during paving operations.
