Drouillard Road Infrastructure Renewal Project Seminole to Tecumseh

Windsor, ON: As part of an ongoing infrastructure renewal program by the Windsor Utilities Commission (WUC), D'Amore Construction (2000) Ltd. will undertake the following construction project, beginning Wednesday, June 20, 2018, weather permitting:

- Construction of a new 200mm diameter PVC watermain on Drouillard Road from Seminole Street southerly to Tecumseh Road East.
- Construction of a new 300mm diameter PVC watermain on Seminole Street from Hickory Road easterly to Drouillard Road.

Please note that the road will be closed, with access to local residents only. The project is expected to take approximately 12 weeks to complete. While every effort is made to minimize traffic impacts and afford local access to residents, occasional delays can be expected. To ensure the safety of our workers, we request that motorists exercise caution when approaching the construction site.

The Windsor Utilities Commission (WUC): WUC owns the water production and distribution infrastructure in the City of Windsor, and the downtown District Energy heating and cooling facilities.
