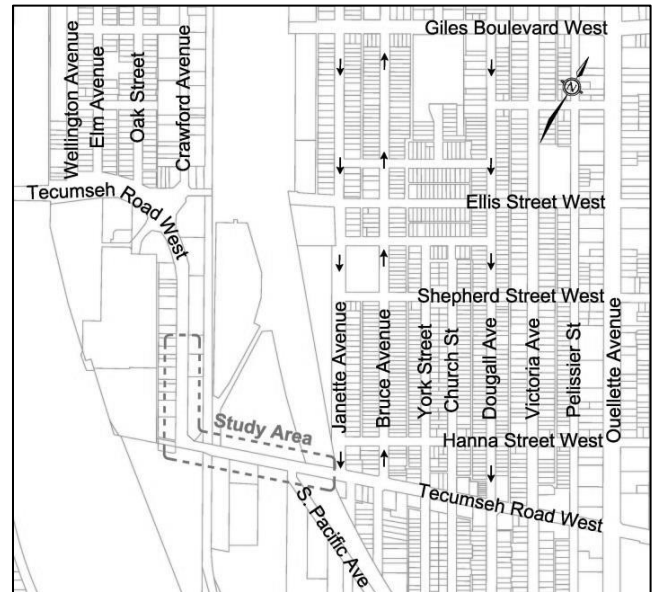


The City of Windsor has completed an Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for the planning and preliminary design of transportation network improvements to Tecumseh Road West between Crawford Avenue and Janette Avenue. The proposed improvements address the transportation needs for a 20-year planning horizon, accommodate all road users, and address rail-crossing requirements. The preferred design was presented to the public at the February 15th, 2018 Public Information Centre (PIC). The preferred plan was refined based on comments received, it includes at-grade improvements with four (4) lanes, a centre turn lane, a multi-use path, and replacement of underground municipal services.

THE PROCESS

The Tecumseh Road West EA was completed as a Schedule ‘C’ project under the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (2015). The study completed all necessary phases of the Municipal Class EA to receive environmental clearance for subsequent design phase and construction, namely:

- Establish the need and justification for the project;
- Document existing environmental conditions;
- Consider all alternatives;
- Proactively involve the public and regulatory agencies in defining a recommended plan; and
- Document the process in an Environmental Study Report (ESR).

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

If there are any concerns regarding the project that cannot be resolved in discussion with the City, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. Requests, with reasons, may be received by the Minister and Director of the Environmental Approvals Branch of the MECP (at the addresses noted below) within 30 days of this notice, prior to December 21, 2018. The request must also be copied to the City’s Manager of Transportation Planning identified below. As of July 1, 2018, a Part II Order Request Form must be used to request a Part II Order in accordance with O. Reg. 152/18. The Part II Order Request Form is available online on the Forms Repository website (<http://www.forms.ssb.gov.on.ca/>) by searching “Part II Order” or “012-2206E” (the form ID number). If there are no requests received within the 30-day review period, the project will receive environmental clearance. Subsequently, the project may proceed to design phase and construction, depending on available funding.
