Description:	<p>The third installment for the 2020 Interim Property Taxes has been changed from April 15, 2020 to June 30, 2020. There will be no late payment charges in either form, penalty and/or interest, through the period ending June 30, 2020.</p>	
Special Conditions:	<p>Property taxes that were required to be paid by April 15, 2020 can be paid anytime between now and June 30, 2020 without penalty or interest charges. All postdated cheques for the April 15, 2020 instalment were cashed unless</p>	

cancelled by the property owner. Charges for Non-Sufficient Funds related to property tax payments will be waived through the period ending June 30, 2020. All remaining pre-authorized payment (PAP) withdrawals scheduled in the months of April, May and June will continue to be taken on the scheduled dates unless otherwise cancelled/adjusted by the property owner. Property owners can contact the City of Windsor Tax Office by email at [propertytax@citywindsor.ca](mailto:propertytax@citywindsor.ca) and make alternate payment arrangements. Please ensure you clearly identify the property address and provide a contact name and number. Owners may be contacted by the Tax Office in the event more information is required.

If you cancelled the PAP plan in April, May or June interest and penalties would apply as of July 1 on any unpaid balances.

Taxpayers on PAP whose accounts are not in arrears as of June 30 will automatically be re-enrolled in the normal PAP. Those taxpayers that have an arrears balance as of June 30th, and who wish to continue to pay by pre-authorized payments, will need to contact the City, via e-mail, ([propertytax@citywindsor.ca](mailto:propertytax@citywindsor.ca))

Property owners who have made arrangements with their financial institution for the payment of property taxes will need to contact their respective institutions to discuss options in regards to any deferral of payments that they may offer.
