## What is the purpose of the Districting Plan?

- Walkerville maintains the distinction of being a vibrant and venerable neighbourhood that possesses some of the richest intact architectural, industrial, natural, and cultural heritage in Ontario, and the Districting Plan is an opportunity to understand, interpret, and contribute to the ongoing evolution of an important piece of Canada's heritage.
- The plan aims to create and strengthen community destinations so that they contribute to Walkerville's unique sense of place, to enhance existing amenities and infrastructure, and to create destinations within the neighbourhood by establishing new physical, cultural, economic, and social connections.
- The plan will provide specific recommendations for initiatives, improvements, projects, and opportunities that will make Walkerville an even more enjoyable place to live, work, and visit.

## What is the purpose of this public engagement workshop?

- Through a process of meaningful public engagement and collaboration, our team wants to explore a future vision for Walkerville with the people who live, work, and play in the neighbourhood. We want to learn about what elements may be missing, and how those gaps can be filled, bridged, and connected in a way that is authentic to Walkerville's history as well as its contemporary identity.

## What input is the consultant team looking for from the public?

- Our team wants to hear how you see Walkerville evolving over the next five, ten, twenty five years, and beyond.
- We want to hear what makes Walkerville such a special place, what could be improved, and your ideas for how to make life in the neighbourhood even better.
- We want to understand what you love about great public spaces all over the world, and how new spaces in Walkerville can be designed to be comfortable, beautiful, welcoming, and inclusive to all.
- We want to explore your ideas of Walkerville's identity, both historically, and today, through the eyes of the people who know it best.
