

Paper Towel Roll Apple Prints

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Paint (yellow, red and green)
- 3 bowls or paper plates
- 3 paper towel rolls
- Paper

WHAT TO DO NEXT:

1. Talk to children about the different colours of apples (red, green, yellow).
2. Pour red, green, and/or yellow paint into 3 separate bowls.
3. Using the empty paper towel rolls, have the child dip the roll into the paint. You can crease the paper towel roll to create an apple-like shape.
4. Stamp the roll onto the paper to make a print and repeat!
5. Extension ideas:
 - Count how many apples on your paper are red, green, and yellow.
 - If you visit an apple orchard or a grocery store, purchase a few different types of apples and try tasting them to see which one you like best. Which type/colour is the sweetest? Which is the sourest?
