### Salad Spinner Art

#### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Salad spinner
- Paint
- Scissors
- Marker
- Cardstock or bristol board



#### WHAT TO DO NEXT:

1. Remove the inside basket from the salad spinner.
2. On a piece of cardstock or bristol board, trace the bottom of the inside basket to give you the appropriate size.
3. Carefully cut out the circle.
4. Place the basket back into the salad spinner, with your newly cut circle inside.
5. Pour paint onto the paper in the basket and then close the lid.
6. Now the fun part begins, spin the handle at various speeds.
7. Open the lid to see your design.
8. At this time, you can add different colour combinations OR start over to create a new design.
